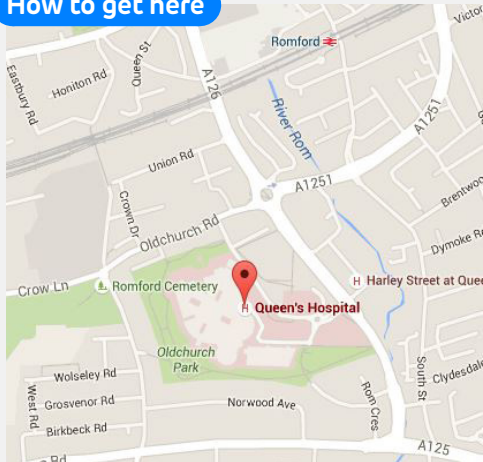

### Venue address

### Travelling by tube

The nearest tube stations are Dagenham Heathway (District line) then 175 bus, or Hornchurch (District line) then 193 bus into the hospital.

### Travelling by train

The closest train station is Romford, which is part of Greater Anglia services.

### Travelling by bus

Buses 128, 175, 193, 365, 496 and 898 all come into the hospital grounds.

Buses 103, 174 and 499 serve Oldchurch Road.

Buses 5 and 294 serve South Street.

### Travelling by car

Car access is through the entrance on Rom Valley Way. If you are travelling by road via the M25, take Junction 28 (A12), then A125 or junction 29 (A127) then A118 to Romford town centre.
