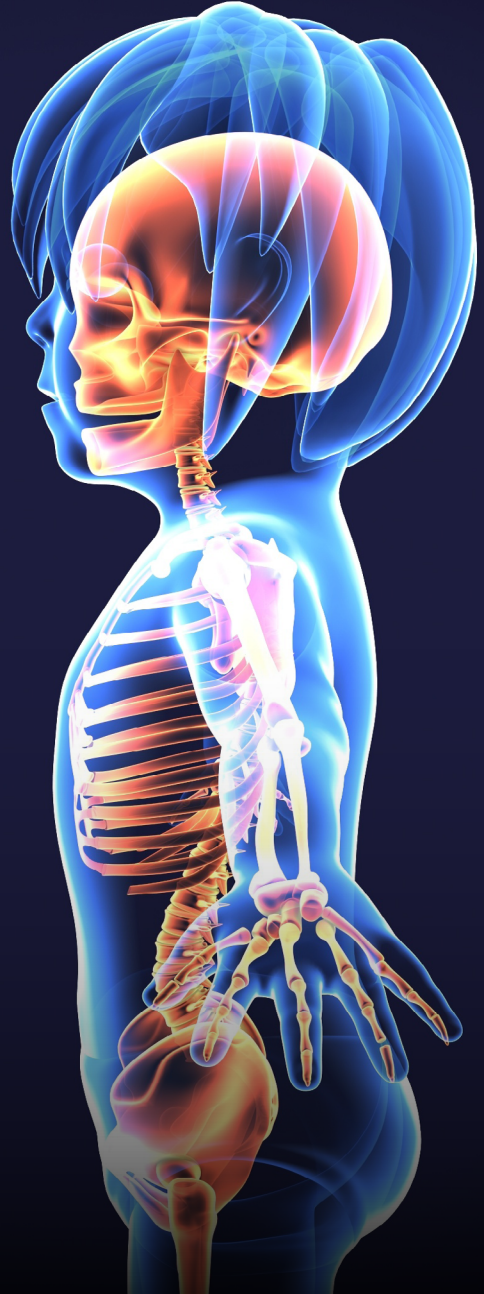

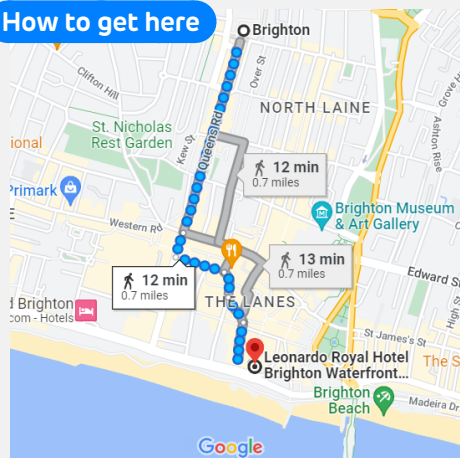

Travelling by train

It is a 15 minute walk to Leonardo Royal Hotel Brighton Waterfront, King's Road, Brighton, BN1 2GS from Brighton mainline train station.

Travelling by car

The Lanes car park is situated just underneath the hotel. There are 2 entrances, one off Black Lyon Street and one directly at the front. The car park is on a first arrive first serve basis therefore spaces cannot be reserved in advance. The hotel lifts are situated on level -2 and -4. A ticket will be provided at the entrance through the machine.

Please keep the ticket and present it at the Front Desk at your check out time or if you need to leave the car park. Our residents receive a discounted rate of £25.00 for 24 hours. Including the resident discount, our car park is one of the cheapest options in Brighton.

Please note, the car park height restriction is 1.91 meters.
