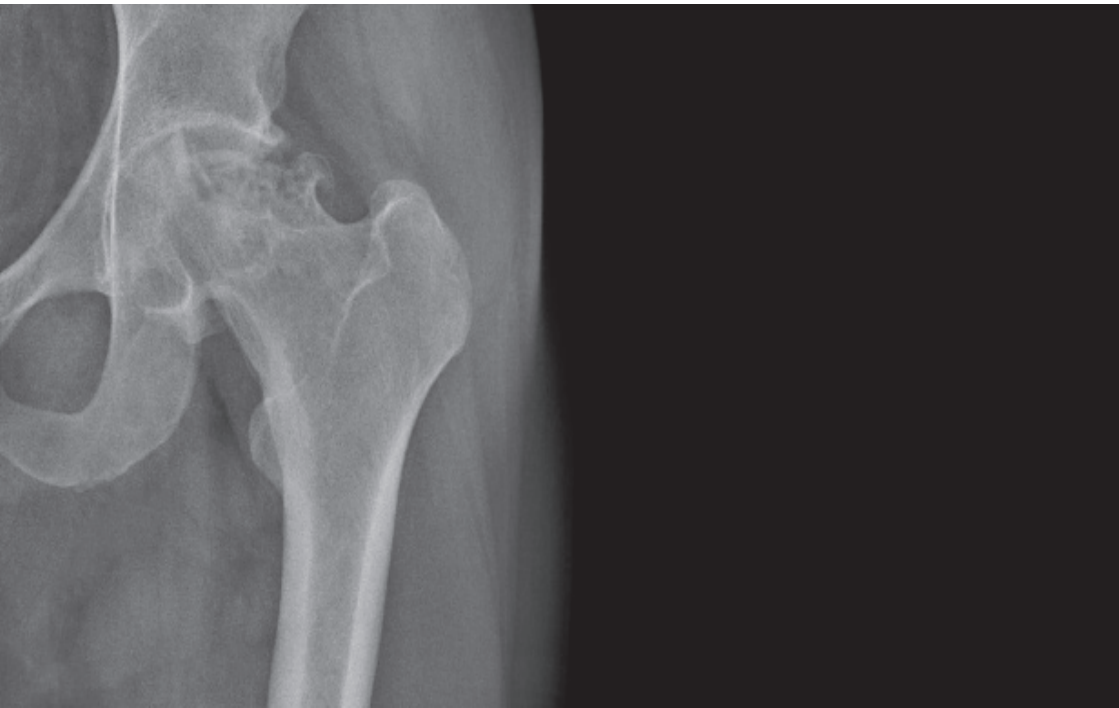

Who should attend?

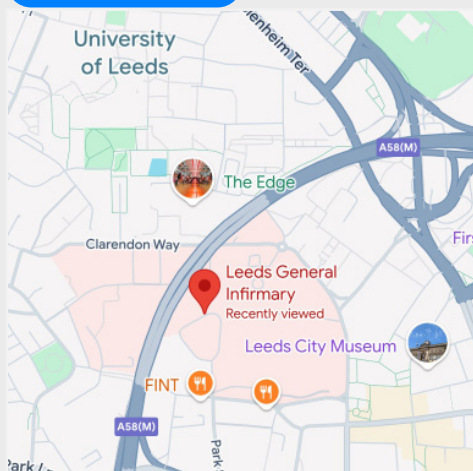
Juniors pre-ST3 (foundation doctors, core surgical trainees), as well as a refresher for ST3-5 training registrars.
